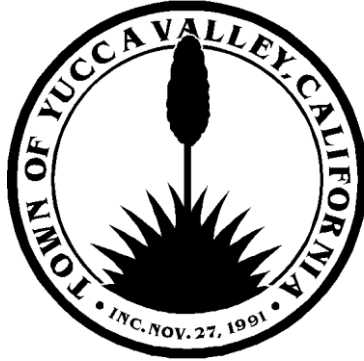

Every effort will be made to read comments aloud which are submitted after 5:00 P.M. and during the meeting, subject to the same 3-minute time limitation. All comments submitted before and during the meeting will be included in their entirety in the official record of the meeting.

4) If you choose to attend the Parks, Recreation, and Cultural Commission meeting in person, seating in the meeting room may be limited in order to accommodate the 6-foot recommended social distancing seating procedure.
